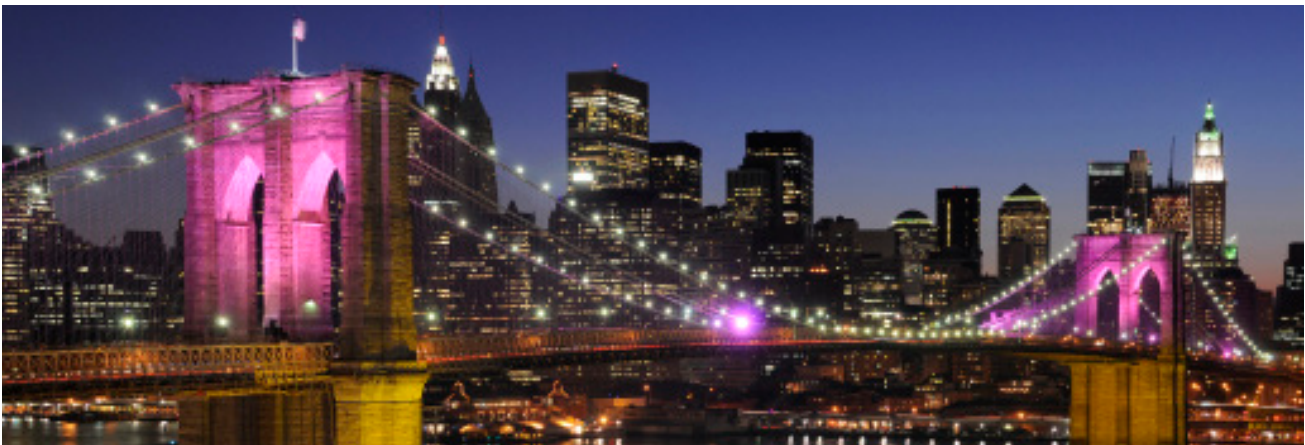

TV & Manhattan Movie Locations Tour

Be amazed at how many iconic television and movie moments were shot within a stone's throw of NBC Studios. Together with your guide, you'll take a guided tour of some of the most famous set locations in NYC from both TV and film. Visit the 9/11 Memorial including the reflection pools and survivor tree, and hear first account stories of tragedy, heroism, and community cohesion from your dedicated guide. This tour also includes pre-reserved, skip-the-line tickets to the 9/11 Memorial Museum where you can spend time on your own.



Iconic Architecture, Private Tour of The Big Apple

FROM NEW YORK CITY • THREE HOURS

Since its founding 400 years ago, New York City has been in a constant state of construction, with the Big Apple's iconic skyline evolving yearly. On your private architectural tour, you will visit the most renowned areas, buildings, and streets of the Big Apple. Of course, you'll see the illustrious skyscrapers like the Chrysler and the 102-story Art Deco Empire State Building, which was the world's tallest building for nearly 40 years. But, not all of New York City's 700,000 buildings touch the clouds. You will also discover lesser-known buildings and areas and learn the backstories of the Big Apple's pioneering architecture, the people, and the politics that made it happen.



Grand Central Terminal Tour

FROM NEW YORK CITY • ONE HOUR THIRTY MINUTES

From secret staircases to a onetime movie theater, there's a lot more to Grand Central Terminal than meets the eye. Your tour begins in Grand Central Terminal's modern-day heart: the lively main concourse. Marvel at the famous clock perched atop the information booth as your guide regales you with the story of Cornelius Vanderbilt, the mastermind behind Grand Central. You'll head into Vanderbilt Hall, gaze at the largest Tiffany clock in the world and then travel back in time to the Roaring 20s into a speakeasy-style bar. The Whispering Gallery, the world's largest lost and found, Graybar Passage and Grand Central Market are also included.



Statue of Liberty Express Tour - Museum & Statue Grounds

FROM NEW YORK CITY • THREE HOURS

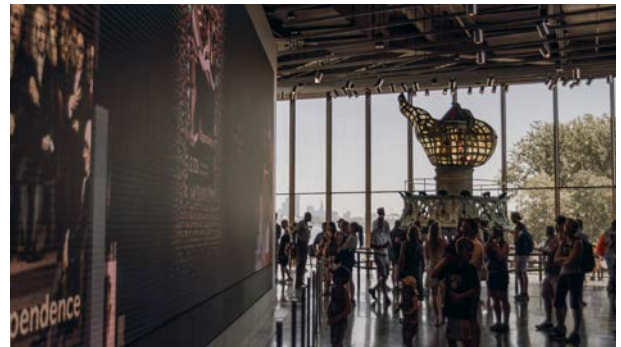
Your tour starts when you meet your expert guide in Battery Park and take in iconic buildings like Castle Clinton (America's first immigration station) and the Pier A Harbor House, before hopping a ferry out to the Statue of Liberty. When you arrive on the Island, you'll dive into the story of how the statue came to be and why it almost wasn't built at all. After a tour of the island, you'll board the ferry again and be back in Battery Park. In just three hours, you'll have seen the Statue and learned its story from an expert guide.



Early Access Statue of Liberty VIP Tour & Ellis Island

FROM NEW YORK CITY • FOUR HOURS

Begin your day at The Battery – the historical gateway to Lady Liberty. Then, board the earliest ferry of the day (morning tour only), and sail away from Manhattan to greet the Statue of Liberty. It is here your guide will dive deep into the story of how Lady Liberty came to be. Take in beautiful views of the famed New York skyline, the Brooklyn Bridge, and the surrounding environs. Wander through the Statue of Liberty Museum and stand mere feet from Lady Liberty's original torch. Next, board for the short ferry ride to Ellis Island. Your guide sets the tone with a brief introduction and then you can explore this special place at your own pace.



Private Full Day Highlights of New York City

FROM NEW YORK CITY • SEVEN HOURS

Explore the Big Apple – from the bustling streets of Downtown Manhattan to the serenity of Central Park. On your private tour of New York City, you will see the best sights of Downtown Manhattan, including Wall Street's Charging Bull, Fearless Girl, and the National 9/11 Memorial. Next, it's on to the bustle of Midtown, including tours of Grand Central Terminal and Times Square. You'll stroll through Central Park, seeing Strawberry Fields and Bethesda Terrace & Fountain. To finish your tour, you'll gaze out over the city from the Rockefeller Center.



The Statue of Liberty & Ellis Island with a Private Guide

FROM NEW YORK CITY • THREE HOURS

See New York from a different perspective on a tour that takes you out to the islands in Upper Bay. With visits to both the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island, you will be able to see New York as so many immigrants did, before they helped grow the wealth and history of America. At the museum, your expert local guide will talk you through some of the exhibits on display. You'll also hear about the fascinating history of the Liberty figure, and how this 100th birthday gift from France was shipped from Paris and finally unveiled in 1886 after 10 years of construction.



Private Walking Tour of Midtown with Empire State Tickets

FROM NEW YORK CITY • THREE HOURS

With many of the city's most famous sights, Midtown Manhattan is one of the best places to experience the spirit of New York. On your private tour, you will stroll glamorous Fifth Avenue to gaze at the world-famous window displays, marvel at Neo-Gothic St Patrick's Cathedral which has been the city's beacon of Catholicism since 1878. Next admire some of Manhattan's most beautiful Art Deco structures, like the Rockefeller building, before stepping into the bright neon lights of Times Square. Learn about the city's rich architectural history, seeing the classics including the Chrysler Building, the Flatiron Building, and Grand Central Terminal and finish with jaw-dropping views from the top of the Empire State Building.



Central Park Walking Tour with a Private Guide

FROM NEW YORK CITY • TWO HOURS

A green haven in the heart of Manhattan, Central Park is a great place to escape the city. On your private walking tour of Central Park, you will stroll down the iconic Mall, which includes the newly erected monument to the Women's March, and statues to literary figures including Shakespeare and Robert Burns. You'll also see the statue dedicated to Balto, the sled dog which helped bring life-saving medicine to children in Alaska. During the two hours you'll visit several iconic places in the park, including Bethesda Terrace and Bethesda Fountain, and see famous filming locations. You finish your tour at one of the most visited spots – Strawberry Fields – where you too can pay tribute to John Lennon.



Private Tour of Little Italy, Soho, Greenwich Village & Chinatown

FROM NEW YORK CITY • THREE HOURS

The different neighbourhoods of New York each have something to give the curious traveller. On this tour you will visit four of its most vibrant districts to see many of New York's off-the-beaten-path sights, all accompanied by a private guide, giving you the history of these famous and disparate neighbourhoods. The tour begins in the avant-garde Greenwich Village, to see where the Friends flat allegedly was, and the Washington Arch. Learn about the Stonewall Riots, and see the Monument dedicated to it. Visit the artistic soul of New York City in Soho, filled with galleries and art museums. And finally, see the impact of immigration in Little Italy and Chinatown.



Private Full Day Tour of the Statue of Liberty & Midtown

FROM NEW YORK CITY • EIGHT HOURS

Enjoy a full day exploring with a private guide. You'll have priority entry into the Liberty Island Ferry Facility, and see the Statue of Liberty up close, learning of her remarkable history and significance to modern America. Explore Ellis Island and witness breathtaking views of the Manhattan skyline from the water. Back on land, you'll stand in the centre of Times Square, discover the theatre district, and admire some of Manhattan's most beautiful Art Deco structures, like the Rockefeller building, and Lawrie's statue of Atlas. Finally, after walking Fifth Avenue to gaze at the world-famous window displays, your tour ends with a visit to the Top of the Rock for impressive views over the city.



Best of Niagara Falls USA Tour (with optional helicopter ride)

FROM NIAGARA FALLS • FOUR HOURS

During this Niagara Falls tour, you'll soak in the finest vistas and experiences the city has to offer while discovering plenty of intriguing facts about the area. Your guide will lead you on the iconic Maid of the Mist boat ride and an exhilarating Cave of the Winds tour, followed by a visit to Goat Island (including Luna Island and Terrapin Point) and Whirlpool State Park. Additionally, you have the option to add a helicopter ride over the Falls to enhance your tour experience. Pick up available from downtown Niagara hotels.



Boutique Wine Tour

FROM NIAGARA FALLS • FOUR HOURS

Set off on an unforgettable adventure through scenic Niagara County. This comprehensive experience guarantees to enchant your senses as you visit four of the area's top wineries, complete with a number of tastings. Immerse yourself in the tranquil countryside, where you'll be greeted with stunning vistas of majestic Lake Ontario. Each of the meticulously chosen wineries presents something unique, from the finest chocolates to local cheeses, and, naturally, a delightful selection of sweet and dry wines. Pick up available from downtown Niagara hotels.



Cave of the Winds Guided Tour

FROM NIAGARA FALLS • TWO HOURS

Seeing all three waterfalls of Niagara Falls on your own can take quite a bit of time. This Niagara Falls and Cave of the Winds Tour allows you to see them all, as well as other highlights, in just a few hours. Your guide takes you to Nikola Tesla Statue, Luna Island, Niagara Gorge Rim Walkway, Cave of the Winds, and so much more. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Day & Night Tour of Niagara Falls

FROM NIAGARA FALLS • FIVE HOURS

During the day, you'll have the opportunity to voyage on the renowned Maid of the Mist boat ride and explore the thrilling Cave of the Winds. As you visit Goat Island and Whirlpool State Park, you'll uncover fascinating tales from the area's history. Come evening, you'll dine at the Steak Stone & Sushi Restaurant before your guide escorts you back to Goat Island for a spectacular view of the illuminated waterfalls. Pick up available from downtown Niagara hotels.



The Best of Buffalo by Bike

FROM BUFFALO • TWO HOURS

Explore downtown with stops at iconic landmarks including Buffalo City Hall, the Electric Tower, and the Guaranty Building, delving into their captivating histories. Uncover tales of bitter rivalries, economic fluctuations, and pioneering community activists pivotal to the city's establishment. From significant events like the Erie Canal and Pan American Exposition to lesser-known narratives of Black history and working-class movements, this Buffalo tour offers insight into the city's rich heritage and its significance in American history. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Hudson River Sightseeing Cruise

FROM ALBANY (HUDSON VALLEY) • ONE HOUR THIRTY MINUTES

Cruise the mighty Hudson River aboard the 'Dutch Apple II' on this Albany sightseeing tour. Listen closely as a Hudson River expert talks about the history of the region and the river, including the evolution of industries. Explore the boat itself, crafted from the popular Hudson River Dayliners of yesteryear, and enjoy the view outside as barges, freighters and tugboats pass by. Bring a camera and/or binoculars to capture the eagles and other wildlife that occupy the region. Transportation to the port is not included.



Archery Experience

FROM ALBANY (HUDSON VALLEY) • ONE HOUR

Urban Archery! Whether it's your first time, first time in a long time, or your first time this week, this is the perfect place to have a couple of drinks, share some laughs, and have a friendly competition with friends and family. The instructors provide a quick tutorial and tips on effective shooting. 2D and 3D targets will be available. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



LEGOLAND® New York Theme Park

FROM GOSHEN (HUDSON VALLEY) • DAY TICKET

Discover LEGOLAND's array of roller coasters and attractions with a full-day admission ticket. Embark on a journey through this theme park, which features seven themed lands, thrilling roller coasters like The Dragon Coaster, and captivating 4D LEGO movies at Palace Cinema. Engage in educational experiences such as imagination-focused programs in LEGO City or lessons at the LEGOLAND driving school. Please note that the park is located in Goshen, a fifty minute drive from Tarrytown or a one-hour drive from Poughkeepsie. Transportation to the park is not included.



Corning Museum Of Glass

FROM CORNING (FINGER LAKES) • ADMISSION TICKET

The Corning Museum of Glass is an institution, and the world's largest glass museum, with 3,500 years' worth of glass artifacts on display. Situated in the picturesque Finger Lakes region of New York, the museum invites visitors to explore the science, art, and history of glass in its galleries. Additionally, guests can witness the creation of glass in a cutting-edge glass-blowing amphitheatre. Transportation to the museum is not included.



Glenn H. Curtiss Museum

FROM HAMMONDSPORT (FINGER LAKES) • ADMISSION TICKET

The Glenn H. Curtiss Museum is a treasure trove of vintage cars, historic aircraft, classic boats, motorcycles, and bicycles. Honouring the legacy of Glenn Hammond Curtiss, the museum houses a priceless collection depicting early aviation and regional history. Alongside viewing the exhibits, visitors are encouraged to explore the Restoration Shop, converse with volunteer craftsmen, and observe them as they meticulously work on historic aircraft. Please note that the museum is located in Hammondsport, a twenty minute drive from Watkins Glenn. Transportation to the museum is not included.



Canandaigua Lake Brewery Tour

FROM FARMINGTON (FINGER LAKES) • FIVE HOURS

Dive into the breathtaking landscapes of the Finger Lakes as you embark on a small-group tasting tour, exploring four of the region's finest craft breweries. Led by a knowledgeable guide, uncover the rich history behind why the Finger Lakes is renowned for its hop cultivation and exceptional craft beer production. At each brewery, indulge in a guided tasting session, sampling a variety of styles while gaining insights into the intricate brewing process. Please note that the meeting point is located in Farmington, a thirty minute drive from Rochester. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Canandaigua Wine Trail

FROM FARMINGTON (FINGER LAKES) • FIVE HOURS

The Canandaigua Wine Trail, New York's original wine country, meanders for nearly 30 miles across the Finger Lakes region. During this tour, you'll have the opportunity to sit back, unwind, and savour tastings at four distinct vineyards focusing on small-batch, exclusive vintage wines. With rolling hills and waterfront vistas, the scenery perfectly complements each sip. Please note that the meeting point is located in Farmington, a thirty minute drive from Rochester. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Farms & Flights Brewery Tour

FROM GENEVA (FINGER LAKES) • FIVE HOURS

Though mostly nanobreweries and microbreweries, New York's Finger Lakes region is all a buzz in the country's craft beer scene. On this guided tour, you'll explore Seneca and Keuka Lake, stopping for tastings at three local hop farms and breweries. From one-off batches to private "hopyards," your guide will highlight some of the rich history which makes the Finger Lakes a perfect place to grow hops and generate great growlers of beer. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Keuka Lake Winery Tour

FROM PENN YAN (FINGER LAKES) • THREE HOURS

Keuka, deriving its name from the indigenous term meaning "Lake with an elbow," stands out among the Finger Lakes for its unique shape and relatively shallow depths. Its shallowness contributes to warmer water temperatures, creating an ideal environment for cultivating premium grapes. Delve into this enchanting tour, commencing with awe-inspiring vistas of the lake, followed by visits of up to four wineries nestled around Keuka Lake. Please note that the meeting point is located in Penn Yan, a twenty minute drive from Geneva or a one hour drive from Ithaca. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Seneca Lake Wine Tasting & Tour

FROM GENEVA (FINGER LAKES) • FIVE HOURS

Seneca Lake stands as the pride of New York's Finger Lakes region, adorned with the prestigious status of an American Viticultural Area and boasting 27 wineries along its shores. On this fun tasting tour, you'll have the opportunity to explore four top vineyards, indulging in a variety of wines. Immerse yourself in the scenic beauty of the surroundings, all while entrusting your journey to the capable hands of your driver. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Guided Black Walnut Tour with Tasting and Hay Ride

FROM PENN YAN (FINGER LAKES) • TWO HOURS

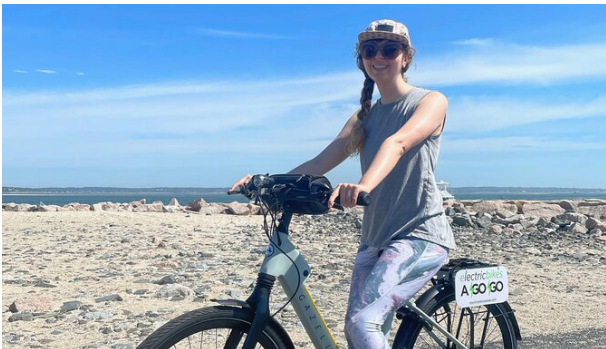
Indulge in cracking and maple glazing your own black walnuts along the Seneca Lake Wine Trail at Black Squirrel Farms, New York's pioneering black walnut processing facility. Join an interactive outdoor tour showcasing the historical, current, and future significance of New York's native walnut. Enjoy a tasting session and a brief hay ride as part of this immersive experience. Please note that the meeting point is in Penn Yan, a twenty minute drive from Geneva. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Dune Road with Breakfast Electric Bike Tour

FROM SOUTHAMPTON (LONG ISLAND) • TWO HOURS

Embark on a captivating eBike journey along the stunning Dune Road, renowned as one of the world's most picturesque waterfronts with its preserved wetlands. Your route spans from Hampton Bay to the charming village of Quogue, offering glimpses of exquisite wild birds like blue herons, snowy egrets, wild ducks, and ospreys. Pause midway through your adventure to enjoy a delightful breakfast at a serene outdoor park nestled within the village of Quogue. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Long Island Winery Tour

FROM RIVERHEAD & MONTAUK (LONG ISLAND) • FIVE HOURS

Relax, enjoy live music, and sip on Long Island wines, ciders and spirits while visiting the area's renowned vineyards including Osprey's Dominion Vineyards and Duck Walk Vineyards. You'll enjoy beautiful views of Long Islands North Fork throughout the day as you make your journey. Before returning home, you'll make a stop at the famous Briermere Farm stand and bakery. Pick-up is available from downtown Riverhead and Montauk hotels.



Oyster Farm Tour

FROM SOUTHOLD (LONG ISLAND) • TWO HOURS

Get a behind-the-scenes peek at a working oyster farm during this guided visit to Southold Bay. Learn about the different stages of oyster farming at all levels of growth, from conception in the hatchery to a look at the market-sized grow-out stage. Tours end with an oyster tasting along the waterfront, paired with local North Fork wine. Please note that the farm is located in Southold, a thirty minute drive from Riverhead. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.



Sunset Electric Bike Tour

FROM BRIDGEHAMPTON (LONG ISLAND) • THREE HOURS

Formerly home to thousands of acres of potato fields and later a quiet retreat for artists and writers, Sagaponack is surrounded by awe-inspiring landscapes and is now well known for its beautiful architecture. Join a small group on this 14 mile guided tour to the pavilion at Sagg Main Beach, and follow much of the historic street racing route of the vintage Bridgehampton Sports Car Races. You'll be travelling at a relaxing, no-rush pace on a modern electric bike. Please note this tour departs from Bridgehampton, a twenty-minute drive from Riverhead and Montauk. Transportation to the meeting point is not included.
